

RESOLUTION COMMITTING LOCAL FUNDS

Resolution No. 2

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hamilton, Illinois has taken action to submit an Illinois Community Development Assistance Program (CDAP) public infrastructure application,

WHEREAS, receipt of CDAP grant assistance is essential to allow the City of Hamilton to undertake the project to replace municipal water systems in a targeted area of the city,

WHEREAS, criteria of CDAP are such that financial participation by the grantee is required in conjunction with CDAP funds, and


WHEREAS, the City of Hamilton has certain monies allocated for the above-referenced project with cash on hand, as needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Hamilton does hereby commit funds from the local water fund for use in conjunction with an Illinois Community Development Assistance Program grant, such funds to equal 25% of the estimated total project cost of \$651,288 or \$201,288.
