Businesses setting up during homecoming days can open at 9am each day and stay open until they decide to close. A decision was made on booth costs. Booth cost will be \$10 for cars. For businesses booths will run \$25 for a (10 x 10) spot for 1-3 days.

Ideas-Trivia night was discussed briefly. We are in agreement with the Friends of the library to partner up with this fundraiser. We need to talk with the library, get a date, time and location.
